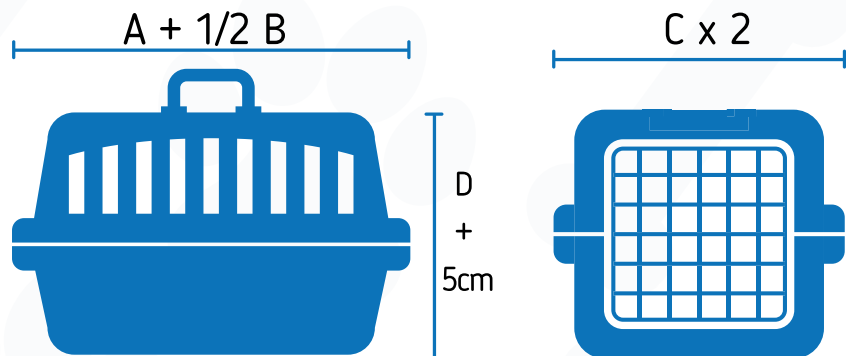
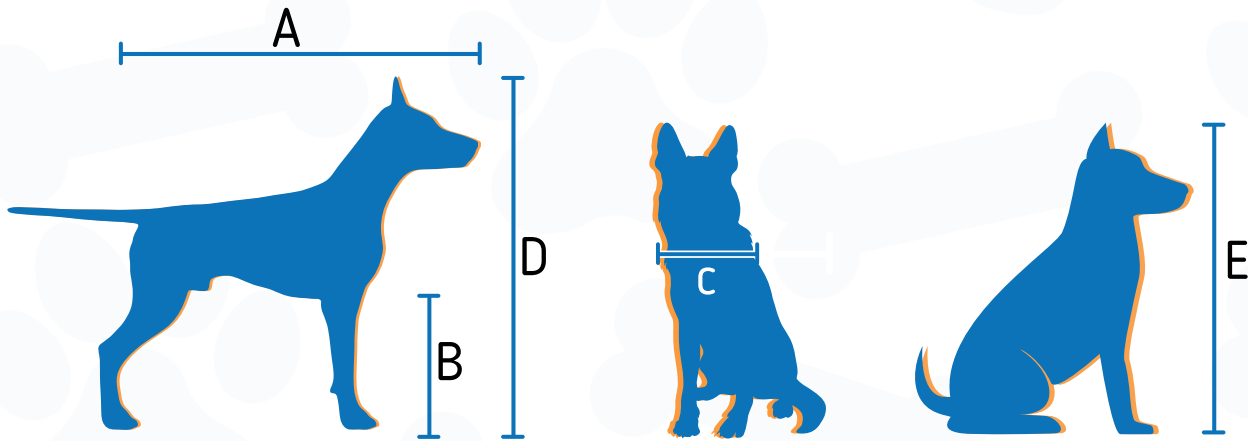

GUIDE: HOW TO MEASURE CARRIER AND PET



INDEX

- A - From the tip of the nose to the root of the tail
- B - From the elbow to the ground
- C - The width at the widest point
- D - From the floor to the tip of the ears or the top of the head, whichever is higher. (Ears must not touch the top of the carrier in animal's natural standing position)
- E - From the floor to the tip of the ears or the top of the head, whichever is higher, in sitting position

ESTIMATE OF CARRIER (measured from the outer perimeter)

- A + 1/2 B - Length
- C x 2 - Width
- D + 5 cm - Height

Carriers should meet the above criteria and the IATA quality standards.
Please use the same guide for cats too.
